Each session consists of two lectures, each approximately 90 minutes long, and discussion. English is the official language of the event.

Distinguished international experts in the field of suicide research and prevention will present these topics at the conference. The conference is hosted by **Professor Diego De Leo**, a leading expert in the area of suicide and the director of the Slovene Centre for Suicide Research. Among his research expertise are definitional issues in suicidology, cultural aspects, international trends and national suicide prevention programs. He was the initiator of the World Suicide Prevention Day, which is celebrated on 10th September every year around the World.

Who can apply?

We encourage professionals, students, scholars and practitioners who are interested in the topic of suicidal behaviours to apply for the participation, e.g. psychologists, psychiatrists, psychotherapists, medical doctors, nurses, social workers, anthropologists, philosophers, sociologists, social scientists, natural scientists, artists ... many professions are listed, as the topic of suicide is very complex, and there is the need for multidisciplinary approaches. We encourage the participation of people from Slovenia, as well as from abroad. We will select 50 participants on the basis of their motivation and career perspectives.

What about the fee costs?
