² If the candidate is already enrolled in the postgraduate 3rd level study programme or holds a master's degree, obtained in a master's study programme adopted in the Republic of Slovenia before 11 June 2004, the average grade of the undergraduate study is not relevant, except in the case of re-enrolment in the first year of the doctoral study programme. For the degree, obtained at a foreign university, the appropriate conversion of grades is considered.

³ The candidate must obtain a degree or a decision of the higher education institution on the recognition of the foreign education with a view to access to education in the Republic of Slovenia with the conversion of the average grade of the undergraduate study according to the Slovenian higher education evaluation system and considering the evaluation system of higher education abroad and obtaining the average grade of all examinations and coursework at least 8,00 by the deadline, specified in the Public Tender.

⁴ The age limit is raised over 28 years, if a candidate for a young researcher has already completed one or two years of post-graduate doctoral studies without financial support. For each finished year a year can be added to the age limit. If the candidate for young researcher has used parental leave for a period of at least six months, considering one year for each child, the age limit shall be raised over 28 years. The same shall apply in the case of extended more than six months documented sick leave.

⁶ In case of co-authorship the appropriate share is calculated by dividing 1,00 point by the number of co-authors.
